## Cataraqui Canoe Club Trip Participant Etiquette



- All participants are expected to adhere to the CCC Code of Conduct as posted on the website RESOURCES By-laws, Policies, Procedures allowing a respectful and safe trip experience for everyone.
- 2. Review the trip description carefully and determine if the trip is appropriate for your abilities and equipment. If uncertain, discuss your concern with the trip leader when signing up.
- 3. Contact the trip leader to sign up for the trip one day or more in advance don't leave it until the night before.
- 4. Show up at the pre-arranged rendezvous point on time.
- 5. Follow the advised route to the launch and travel in a convoy to avoid getting lost before the trip.
- 6. Similarly, follow the advised route for any car shuttle and travel in a convoy to avoid getting lost before the trip.
- 7. Listen to the pre-trip briefing.
- 8. Get your boat ready and launch quickly, clearing the launch area to make room for others.
- 9. Do not depart from the launch area until all participants are on the water.
- 10. Stay with the group, within hailing distance of the nearest participant.
- 11. Don't delay or lead astray any of the group
- 12. Stay close to the leader (within whistle distance).
- 13. Watch out for and help your fellow participants
- 14. Stay within your limitations and tell the leader or the sweep if you are in difficulty.
- 15. Tell the leader or the sweep if you are leaving the group for any reason.
